POLICY

Council of the College of Alberta Denturists is required pursuant to section s. 3(1)(c) of the *Denturists Profession Regulation*, to approve a registration examination in denturism acceptable in matters related to registration as a regulated member. Pursuant to s. 3(1)(c), the College has approved the successful completion of two components:

- either the College of Alberta Denturists multiple choice question examination (MCQ) or the Canadian multijurisdictional denturist MCQ exam, and
- the College of Alberta Denturists objective structured clinical examination.

A candidate must successfully pass both components of the exam to be considered to have passed the registration examination and be eligible for registration as a regulated member on the general register.

Reporting to candidate

Following an exam attempt, each candidate will receive notification from the College via email of their exam results for each exam component. If the candidate is unsuccessful at one or both exam components, a copy of the candidate's results histogram for the applicable component(s) will also be provided to the candidate.

Reporting to program

Following the release of examination results, on an annual basis, the entry-to-practice program will receive for the students it graduated:

- Education program pass rates initial and rewrite
- Annual pass rates for the previous three years initial writes ONLY
- Performance profiles of each failed student with all student identifying information removed
