# POLICY

Section 3(1)(c) of the *Denturists Profession Regulation* states that applicants for registration must have successfully completed an examination approved by Council.

Council approves the following exams to meet the above criterion:

- III Canadian denturist multijurisdictional registration examination multiple choice question exam
- College of Alberta Denturists objective structured clinical examination (OSCE)
- 🛿 Canadian denturist multijurisdictional registration examination OSCE

An examination candidate must have successfully challenged the multiple-choice examination (MCQ) exam and an objective structured clinical examination (OSCE) to be considered to have met the examination requirement for registration.
