POLICY

The College of Alberta Denturists issues an annual practice permit to regulated members. This includes general, provisional, and courtesy regulated members.

Members are required to attain a practice permit from the College or their online College profile and print in a professional manner.

The College requires that the regulated member display their current and valid practice permit in each location where they are providing denturist services. This may include, but is not limited to, a clinic, laboratory, or educational institute.

Further, the member's practice permit must be displayed in an area where it may easily be viewed by the public who enter the premises.

If care and services are provided by the denturist in a remote situation, the denturist must be able to produce their practice permit on demand.
